- Internal controls - fraud prevention, fiscal accountability, policies and procedures
- Conflicts of interest
- Regulatory requirements

Serving as a trustee, director, or board member should not be treated as an honorary title. This presentation will equip current and future nonprofit leaders with tools on how to approach their important role with confidence.
