FACTSHEET

95% of the pharmacies nationwide have agreed to provide lower pricing to everyone that brings in a FamilyWize prescription drug discount card. This can help so many people in our community buy the medicine they need to stay healthy.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Average Discount = 35% or more – about \$20 per prescription.
- Accepted at most pharmacies nationwide, including all major chains.
- Covers all FDA-approved prescription drugs.
- No age, income or residency restrictions. Anyone can use it.
- Covers everyone with no health insurance or prescription coverage.
- All cards are bilingual, in English and Spanish.
- Covers all medicine not covered by insurance, Medicaid, Medicare, or other benefit plans.
- No registration, activation, paperwork or enrollment. No personal information is collected.
- No cost to the United Way, your organization, or people using the cards.



HOW IT'S FUNDED

The savings on the cost of the medicine is provided by the pharmacies. They have agreed to accept prices for medications that are close to the prices they make available to large insurance companies and employers. All other program costs are provided by part of the processing fee included in the cost of the medicine and by in-kind donations from the program sponsors.
